China has seen recent outbreaks of severe acute respiratory syndrome (SARS), avian influenza, dengue fever, and severe fever with thrombocytopenia syndrome (SFTS). They are caused by viruses and each have a complex etiology requiring interdisciplinary research approaches. They all move from animals to infect humans. Hence, health care workers and public health researchers must partner with veterinarians, wildlife professionals and even entomologists in understanding them. Food safety issues and the increase in antibiotic-resistant pathogens also require interdisciplinary research.
