### ABSTRACT:

Dr. Wibowo will present several 'stories from the field', focusing on maternal health, to highlight the challenges, success and failures of global health initiatives in Indonesia. She will also call attention to our future challenges and why it is imperative that we develop well-trained and passionate global health leaders. In this colloquium, students, staff, and faculty will be invited to think about what global health issues we might face in the future and how we might use the lessons of today to develop the solutions of tomorrow together.

### BIO:

Dr. Wibowo is senior expert in public health from the University of Indonesia, with extensive experience working in various high level health agencies, including the World Health Organization (WHO). In 1997, she joined the WHO South East Asia Regional Office in India where she served as the Regional Adviser for Research Policy-Cooperation and Health Ethics for 7 years. She was then promoted as the WHO Representative for the country of Nepal and later promoted again as WHO Representative for the country of Myanmar. Presently, Dr. Wibowo serves as senior faculty member at the University of Indonesia's School of Public Health and as a national consultant for UNDP, UNFPA, UNICEF, WHO, the National Family Planning Board and other health related organizations in Indonesia. In November 2017, she founded the Global Health Initiative Indonesia (GHII) under the auspices of

CHAMPS FPHUI, with its overall goal is to produce competent, ethical and reflective young professionals who have acquired the awareness, knowledge and skills fundamental to the practice of global health at the national, regional and international arena.

Dr. Wibowo earned her medical degree (MD) from the Faculty of Medicine Universitas Padjadjaran Indonesia in 1973, a Master of Public Health (MPH) from the School of Public Health University of Hawaii USA in 1976, a Certificate in International Health from the Johns Hopkins University School of Hygiene USA, and finally a Doctor of Public Health (DrPH) from the School of Public Health University of Berkeley and University of Indonesia in 1992.
