 external communications materials; and handling other editorial and related duties as assigned.
- Build and maintain solid working relationships with Chinese-language media outlets and KOLs in China and across the globe.
- Develop and implement communications initiatives including interviews, media workshops and media events.
- Manage third-party agencies and communications budget.
- Other tasks as assigned.

 University grows in size and complexity in its programs.
