

## PACKING CHECKLIST

We recommend that you bring the following items, some of which are also purchasable from the campus mini-mart (8:00am – 8:00pm) and supermarkets:

### What to Bring

1. Chinese ID card/Passport
2. Cash, debit or credit cards
3. Travel insurance documents/insurance card (for students not enrolled in the DKU insurance plan).
4. Any prescribed medication and letter from the doctor.
5. X-Ray Report (either electric or paper) and all kind of blood test report which are required for Health Check if you have taken it after May 16<sup>th</sup>, 2019 to avoid the risk of double checking.
6. Four (4) copies of color photo (3.5 x 4.5 cm or 1.38x1.77 inches, for resident permit) with white background (international students).
7. Photocopies of your passport pages, including the visa (international students).
8. Duke Kunshan Admission Letter, original (international students).
9. Enough clothes to last you until you get settled.
10. Study materials, including laptop, chargers, phone, and camera.
11. Your own set of beddings, including pillows, pillow cases, blankets, sheets, and wash towels. The mattress size is 1100mm(W) \*2000mm (L)\*220mm (H) (Conference Center), and 965mm (W) 2030mm (L) 300mm (H) (Residence Hall).
12. Toiletries, e.g. toilet paper, shampoo, body wash, soap, hand-wash, toothbrush, and tooth paste, etc.
13. Room supplies, e.g. kettle (provided in Conference Center rooms; hot water dispense is available in the Residence Hall common areas), trash bags, hangers, storage boxes, cleaning supplies and adapter (international students).
14. Laundry supplies, e.g. laundry detergent and laundry bags.
15. First aid kit (In the Conference Center, it's also accessible at the front desk and the fitness center. In the Residence Hall, it's also accessible at the 2F student lounge, hallway between Block 1&2, hallway between Block 3&4 and 1F Student Affairs Office).
16. Personal supplies, e.g. facial cleanser, moisturizer, cosmetics, shaving supplies, and hair dryer, etc.

### What NOT to Bring

To ensure health and safety in the residence hall, the following items are prohibited:

- Weapons (include fireworks).
- Drugs of any kind.
- Pets of any kind.
- Flammable decorations and appliances that may be deemed a fire hazard, including candles, mosquito incense, heaters, electric blankets, extension cords, and iron (available in laundry room).
- Cooking appliances, including rice cookers, toasters, toaster ovens, hot plates, grills, hot pots, blenders, coffee machines, microwave (available in all buildings).
- Other electric appliances, including washing machines (available in laundry room), dryers (available in laundry room), refrigerator (communal refrigerator and university rental refrigerators are available).
