Institutional Summary:

The Global Health Research Center (<https://dukekunshan.edu.cn/en/research/global-health-research-center>) and Environmental Research Center (<https://dukekunshan.edu.cn/en/research/environmental-research-center>), Duke Kunshan University seek to hire full-time student research assistants (intern) at the graduate or undergraduate level to work at the Duke Kunshan University in Kunshan, China. The interns will work in the area of health policy and systems and environmental health, specifically on a Gates Foundation-funded project titled as “Achieving Health Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs) in China: Developing Evidence-based Policy Options for Action” (SDG Project), to develop evidence-based policy options for actions to support China in achieving the health SDGs (<https://sustainabledevelopment.un.org/?menu=1300>) established by the United Nations and the “Healthy China 2030” plan for 2016-2030 developed by the Chinese Government.

Duke Kunshan University is a partnership of Duke University, Wuhan University and the Municipality of Kunshan, China. The Duke Kunshan University campus is located 37 miles west of Shanghai in Kunshan, which is connected to Shanghai via a 15-minute high-speed train. This position is located in Kunshan City, Jiangsu Province, China.

About the SDG project:

China has made significant efforts in achieving the Millennium Development Goals by addressing the multi-dimensional nature of poverty and focusing on sustainable and equitable wellbeing. Compared with the MDGs, the SDGs set a broader health agenda for development and it calls for urgent actions, from China and the world, to craft effective solutions to achieve the health SDGs. The Government of China therefore needs to develop evidence-based health policies that can be practically and effectively implemented in different regions of the country in the next fifteen years to achieve the health SDG targets.

Founded by the Gates and Melinda Foundation with the vision that “all lives have equal value”, this project aims to generate sound evidence that can be used by the government to develop informed health policies for China in the next 15 years to achieve the health SDGs for health equity. This 2-year research project, kicked off in September 2016, will be undertaken under the leadership of Prof. Shenglan Tang from Duke University and Duke Kunshan University and through collaboration with five Chinese institutions, including Development Research Center (DRC) of the State council, China’s National Health Development Research Center, Wuhan University, Fudan University and Kunming Medical University.

Essential Duties:

Under the supervision of senior researchers and faculty and independently (listed in descending order of time allocation and priority),

- Work on the SDG project to conduct literature review, research development, project management, interviews, and translating project documents, drafting project reports, and other related tasks.
- Data entry, analysis and statistical model building using EpiData, STATA, SAS or other statistical software research projects;
- Any other research and administrative tasks required by the team leader.

Qualifications:

- Have strong interests and experiences in health policy research and environmental health research;
- Enrolled in a degree-granting educational institution, graduate students preferred; Advanced undergraduate students also considered;
- Willing to travel as needed to field sites and conferences;
- Proficient and experienced in using MS Office, EpiData, STATA or SAS (preferred, not required);
- Hardworking, fast learner, team player, and attention to detail;
- Thrive working in a multidisciplinary environment;
- Excellent oral and written communication skills, in both English and Chinese;
- 6 months internship duration minimum and longer term preferred.

Terms and Compensation:

- Open ONLY to Chinese citizens who are enrolled in a degree-granting educational institution (can be Chinese or foreign institutions).
- This is a paid internship with monthly stipend.
